

1. East Ayrshire Car Club Ltd will promote a Rally Time Trial Championship for the 2010 season. The Championship will be known as the East Ayrshire Rally Time Trial Championship
MSA PERMIT No. 1/2010
2. The Championship is open to all fully elected members of any MSA registered Car Club which are recognised in one of the following Regional Association of Motor Clubs: Scottish Association of Car Clubs, Association of North East and Cumbria Car Clubs, as detailed in the Competitors and Officials 'Blue Book'.
3. The Championship will consist of 4 classes:
 - Class 1 Cars up to 1400cc
 - Class 2 Cars between 1401cc and 1700cc
 - Class 3 Cars between 1701cc and 2099cc
 - Class 4 Cars over 2100cc

Cars with forced induction will have their capacity multiplied by 1.7 to determine class eligibility.

The exact cubic capacity must be declared on the Championship registration form. False declaration will result in exclusion.

All vehicles must conform to all relevant 2010 MSA Safety Regulations.

Competitors wishing to change classes during the Championship must inform the Championship Co-ordinator no less than 48 hours prior to an event. Not informing the co-ordinator may result in no points being awarded.

4. The following 4 events will make up the 2010 East Ayrshire Rally Championship.

Should less than four events be run, there will be a reduction in the number of scores that count to overall awards as follows:

4	3
3	3
2 or less	All scores to count

If, through force majeure, any of the above qualifying rounds are postponed or cancelled, the Championship Promoters reserve the right to substitute an alternative event where available, subject to notification of the MSA and all Registered Competitors. Any other changes carried out by the Championship promoters will be in accordance with the MSA Yearbook. Any changes and announcements regarding the championship will be in the form of Official Bulletins.

5. All Drivers and Co-drivers must register for the championship on the official registration form with the correct fee in order to claim points and be eligible

for prizes. The Registration fee is £10 for Driver or Co-driver, or £15 per crew. All cheques should be made payable to East Ayrshire Car Club Ltd. Registration opens on publication of these Supplementary Regulations, and closes at the end of Documentation of Round 3 of the Championship.

6. Points will be awarded as follows:
- 1st in Class 10 Points
 - 2nd in Class 8 Points
 - 3rd in Class 7 Points
 - 4th in Class 6 Points
 - 5th in Class 5 Points
 - 6th in Class 4 Points
 - 7th in Class 3 Points
 - 8th in Class 2 Points
 - 9th in Class 1 Point

Points will be awarded to drivers and co-drivers individually on a class-position basis. Competitor points will be cumulative, which will allow competitors to count points from more than one class to their overall total.

If there are less than 2 registered starters in a class on any event, then the maximum points which will be awarded will be the points for 2nd place, i.e. 8 points.

Any ties will be decided in favour of the competitor with the greatest number of maximum scores within their best four scores. In the event of a further tie the greatest number of second highest scores shall decide and so on. Should this fail to resolve the tie then, as this is a class based championship, there is no fair alternative but to let the tie stand and the prize shall be split.

in accordance with D26.1.2 after each round the points will be published and will remain provisional for seven days from the date of publication. Any query regarding Championship points and positions or any other matter must be made in writing, within that time, to the Championship Co-ordinator who will attempt to resolve the matter, and if the dispute remains unresolved, it will be referred to the Championship Stewards.

7. In order to qualify for championship points all competitors must display the Championship stickers with any sponsor's names on both sides of the car, as per 2010 Blue Book H29 This will be strictly enforced. No stickers = No points.

Once a competitor has registered for the Championship it is not possible to de-register. Even if the championship decals are removed, competitors will still be counted as a registered competitor for the allocation of Championship points, even though they will not be awarded any individual points. These points will not be reallocated.

8. Awards will be made as follows:

Overall Awards: 1st Overall Award to Driver & Co-driver

2nd Overall Award to Driver & Co-driver

3rd Overall Award to Driver & Co-driver

Class Awards: 1st Overall* Award to Driver & Co-driver

2nd Overall* Award to Driver & Co-driver

* Overall winners will not be eligible for class awards.

Ladies Award Award to 1st Lady Competitor

Best Newcomer Award to highest scoring competitor in their 1st year of competition.

Registered competitors must start a minimum of 2 events to be eligible to win prizes.

9. The Co-ordinator will compile a list of registered competitors and their contact details and forward these to the organisers of the championship-counting events where possible. However, this does not guarantee an entry. As some events have limited spaces available, it is the competitor's responsibility to obtain event regulations and apply for entries as soon as possible to all events in the championship.
