East Ayrshire Car Club are pleased to announce their Kames Classic Vehicle Show will take place again in 2015, on August 2nd, the corresponding date to the inaugural 2014 show.

Regulations will be available in the Spring after which entries will be accepted from private owners and from Owners' Clubs.

The Show Committee have discussed various points of praise, criticism and suggestions raised by it's members, by owners, clubs, judges and members of the public, and intend to address these in planning the next gathering.

It is hoped to open documentation earlier, from 9.a.m., possibly with two vehicle entrance points and two documentation points, one for privateers and another for Club entrants. As before it is planned to confine private entries to the surfaced paddock areas and the Club cars to the grass areas, all of which will be within a few feet of a tarmacadam road. Club tents will again be encouraged (at no cost) as long as the organisers are advised on the entry forms to help plan the layout efficiently. Trade stands will be located next to where the East Ayrshire Car Club stand was in 2014.

Our entry list of around 220 last August took us by surprise, and for the organisation to run as smoothly as we would like, changes will be needed, these for the benefit of marshals and entrants alike and the co-operation of owners is requested in these matters.

While Clubs are encouraged to bring their members to the Show, the Club stands must be for Classic exhibits alone and not for general club members' non-classic cars, this aimed at maintaining the standard of vehicles on display. It may be possible to reserve a pre-arranged area of the public car park for such members by special arrangement with the organisers well in advance of the Show.

The Show Committee would like to apply stricter control of entries to avoid the last minute changes which gave the judges many problems last year. Any vehicle not in the official programme will not be judged.

The class structures and the judging procedures are being revised for 2015 and motor-cycles may be included.

The purpose of this letter is to inform owners of our intention to make the coming Show even better and to enable Clubs contact their members and organise their club outing.
