# Superlap Scotland/British Sprint Championship 25/26<sup>th</sup> July

The July 25<sup>th</sup> / 26<sup>th</sup> Knockhill Motor Sports Club organised event will be the busiest yet run by the Club. It will feature Rounds 4 & 5 of Super Lap Scotland, a round of the British Sprint Championship, a visit by the Northern Saloon and Sports Cars from our friends at the DDMC and Scotlands first Ken Block style Gymkhana (autotest to you and me!). SLS is really taking hold and is now attracting an entry of around 50 cars , from the top Pro Class with some 400 – 1000bhp, to Class E for more conventional cars featuring road and track cars. SLS is so accessible and with the Super Sprint format, allows for a lot of track time in the morning before the timed qualifying and Super Lap final itself. There is a great comradery now within the SLS paddock and a feeling that numbers should only grow steadying as this event is also televised on Motors TV, taking the championship to a new audience. The Gymkhana is being running with help of long established autotest organisers and will bring this discipline to a new audience too and the British Sprint should bring some of the UK's fastest drivers to Scotland.

The event is being run over two days on Knockhill's unique Twin Track format with Round 4 happening on the reverse direction configuration with Sunday happening in the clockwise direction. This will give all competitors two rounds, on two days, in two directions all at the one venue!

Spaces and entries are available for anyone wanting to enter the British Sprint Championship as a one off at Knockhill on the 25<sup>th</sup> / 26<sup>th</sup> July. Run by the KMSC, the entry fee is £130 per event day, and if a competitor wishes a space in the garages, it's a further £40.
