RECORD CROWD AT KAMES TROPHY

For the third successive weekend the sun shone on Kames for the Albar Kames Trophy Rally on July 14th and this undoubtedly contributed to the biggest spectator turnout we can remember at the track.

There was a full entry of 30 cars, around half of whom were in the Junior class contesting the Brick & Steel Ecosse F1000 Junior Championship but some familiar faces were missing from the main entry, Bernie Rooney still recovering from his big operation (but there spectating), Alastair Cunningham having sold his Manta and the McCulloch Nova still in pieces.

Andrew Gallacher was a late entry and considered to be the main threat to past winner and a favourite with the Kames gallery Alan Gardiner, but the Hurlford man retired early on with transmission problems. Another late entry was Linzi Henderson having graduated from the Juniors to an Impreza with double the engine capacity. She was to give a very good account of herself, finishing in the middle of the Seniors.

After three stages Andrew led by one second from Alan but when his rival retired on SS4 the Mull man gradually pulled out a healthy lead in his black Mk1 Escort. Back on leave from his job in the Congo Duncan Ferguson but on a superb show without ever getting to grips with the islander.

Favourite to win the Juniors rally, Alex Vassallo was unbeaten till he dropped over three minutes on SS6 which put him out of contention. Michael Dickie then took over but he came under pressure from Harry Marchbank but held on for an uncomfortably narrow two second victory. Their times would have put them half way up a combined results table.

There was a great atmosphere with many spectators turning their outing into a picnic. There were a few delays, yet many spectators remained to the very end, giving us hope the next rally in late September will also be well supported.
