The 2012 speed season got off to a rousing start at Kames on April 14/15th with the first two rounds of the Guyson Sco sh Sprint Championship. The bi erly cold weather remained dry for the Saturday when Ross Napier, deser ng his father's Gould V8 for the ex-John Plenderleath Radical Prosport set FTD with a very smooth performance. He has always preferred the an clockwise course and it showed as he headed all the small singleseaters. New class records were set by Gary Buchan (Nova) from Caithness on his first visit to Kames, Stephen Alexander (Wes ield), Sco Bea e(Fiesta) and Ross Napier.

The following day which was not quite as cold belonged to Wallace Menzies who was giving his 3.2 litre DJ Firestorm an airing before star ng his Bri sh Hillclimb Championship campaign. He set FTD in an outright record me and he was followed home by his wife Nicola in he Force PC. Class records fell to Gary Buchan, Nick Barra (Mini), Mark Purdham (MJ Eng Hosson-Bouler), Sco Bea e and, of course Wallace Menzies.

Another feature of this memorable weekend was the large number of new faces including two teenagers making their debuts, Cameron Fair in his Peugeot 205 and Louise Calder in a 1000cc Jedi. Louise's dad Colin who oversaw the Muirkirk visit and big sister Heather are both contes ng the 2012 Bri sh Sprint Championship in the ex-Nick Algar V8 Gould.

David Loomes went off on first Sunday practice on the approach to the hairpin, crashing into the tyre beling and inflicing a fair bit of damage to the Wesi eld. The MNR Vortex of Paul Lawrence is now supercharged but it was reired on Saturday morning before it could show its paces. Both meeings were very well supported with 45 on Saturday and 80 on Sunday, boosted by over a dozen contesting Wigton Motor Club's Cross Border Championship on the second day.

Compe tors and officials were apprecia ve of the efforts of the marshalling force in condi ons which were a bit tes ng at mes. Well done to all concerned.
